Program & Event Partnerships

First Day Hikes (January 1): A collaborative regional effort that encourages people to get outdoors with free guided walks and activities to explore Cape Cod's parks, trails, and natural resources on the first day of the year.

Celebrate Earth Month (April): A month-long family-friendly program celebrating Mother Earth includes story times, craft workshops, nature walks and talks, and more. (8-10 programs)

Hike Barnstable (June): Celebrating "Great Outdoors Month®", this initiative encourages hikers of all ages and abilities to get outside and explore! Related events spotlight the health and wellness benefits of hiking, being outdoors, and exploring our natural environment in new ways. (10+ programs)

Flower Pot Music Concert (June): This innovative participatory musical that celebrates the summer solstice and our natural environment is held at BLT's Ropes Field in Cotuit and includes Cape Cod Symphony and the Cotuit Library as partners.

Annual Meeting (July): A gathering of BLT members to share exciting updates and accomplishments, conduct a brief business meeting, and celebrate our Founders Award and President's Award winners.

BLT's Climate Month (September): This collection of new program's explores climate-related topics through walks and talks as well as through art, literature, and science programs culminating in a Rising Waters temporary public art installation in Hyannis by members of the community. (10+ programs)

eARTh Connections (Year-long): Providing creative connections to conservation, local and visiting artists will provide programs, lectures, and workshops culminating during October which is National Arts & Humanities Month.

Leadership Council (Spring/Fall): The Leadership Council recognizes distinguished leaders in the community who support conservation. The group convenes annually for two in-person receptions to stay informed, provide advice and network.
