The Cape Cod Pathways

project was originally planned in 1993 by the Barnstable County Commissioners, with the goal of creating a regional system of trails from one end of the Cape to the other. Today, walking trails traverse a mosaic of lands and cover over 21 miles, beginning in Sandwich and ending in Yarmouth. Final implementation of the plan will require the acquisition of critical links, and consistent trail maintenance with the help of volunteers and other organizations.

 - North Loop - 4.5 miles
 - South Loop - 5.5 miles
- 18 kiosks
- 16 parking areas to access
- 8 conservation areas
